1. Register and create a login with your students.tas.tw or tas.edu.tw email address.

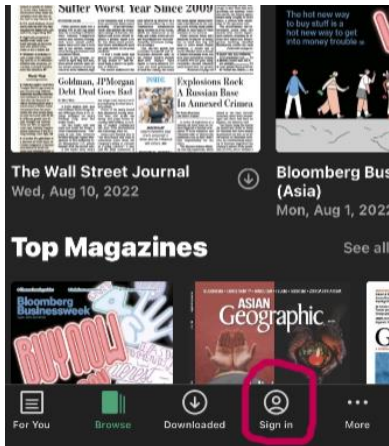
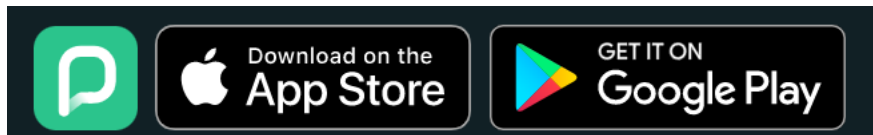


If you have not logged into any resources on our site, you will be prompted to login with your student login. Just use the same username and password that you use with everything else on campus.

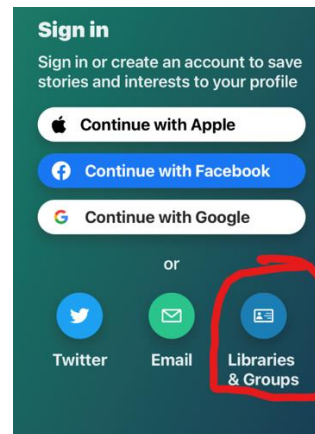
Press Reader can be hard to use unless you use the text option. To use the text option, click twice or more on the article title.
